## OGeez! Gears Up for Summer peculation is running wild about what OGeez! is planning for its

fourth-annual Limited Edition Summer Gummy. Like last year, cannabis activists across the globe have launched a pressure campaign to push OGeez! to reveal details about the

gummy early. Their hashtags — #CantTakeTheWait and #TellUsNow — have both gone viral.

One source said the company's top brass even suspect that activists have infiltrated their facilities as undercover employees to get intel on the summer gummy.

But the company is keeping all of those details under lock and key.

"The branded bags are being kept in a secure, undisclosed location," said a source. "Even the employees

making the gummies won't know what they're making until it's announced." An OGeez! spokesperson said, however, that the summer gummy will be a "huge surprise" and

"something completely different" this year in honor of the company's late founder, Peggy Noonan. "Before we even roll this out, I can tell you that the reaction is going to be huge and that there's going to

be insane demand," the spokesperson said. This is the first year that OGeez! is launching the summer gummy in three states. Since last

summer, the company has expanded beyond its Arizona homebase to both Illinois and New Jersey. The Limited Edition Summer Gummy launches on June 21 (the first day of summer) and wraps sales on the last day of summer (September 22). Stay tuned!

With the guessing game in overdrive about this year's summer gummy, The Dispatch is remembering the past summer sensations that wowed the cannabis world.

"It's a spectacular facility, right on the beach," said one Piña Colada gummy.

During the off season the veteran gummies test new summer options and train the upcoming summer gummies for the celebrity-lifestyle that awaits them once they launch. But when summer starts, they pamper themselves in the facility's spas and hang out on the beaches.

**OGeez!** Wows at **MJ** Unpacked

Geez! was back on the New Jersey networking scene last month, this time at the esteemed MJ Unpacked in Atlantic City. The event — which was held at the Hard Rock Hotel — is known for

bringing together a highly curated crowd of cannabis investors along with retail and brand executives and for providing serious deal-making opportunities.

"Everyone's juices were flowing," said one source. "The place was buzzing with people arranging new investments and locking in new partnerships.'

OGeez! had an elaborate display that included a glass museum-like case housing some of the company's original artifacts, including the original OGeez! yo-yo that late company founder Peggy Noonan played with as a little girl.

Sources said the company also had "killer giveaway bags" that included glossy copies of The Dispatch, along with a bunch of "amazing swag."

OGeez! CEO Bran Noonan spoke on a panel about the increasing number of brands competing for limited shelf space. "It was terrific," one guest told The Dispatch. "We walked away with a lot of key market intelligence."



**OGeez!** Ramps Up Activity in IL

Geez! events are coming fast and furious in Illinois. The company is crisscrossing the state as it carves out a name for itself in the midwestern market.

One source said "it's no easy feat to crack into this market," which is flooded with brands and saw \$2 billion in sales last year. "But that's exactly what OGeez! is doing," the source said.

The OGeez! Gummy Making Workshops have, for example, caught on like wildfire. The company is hosting another this month at Emerald Lounge in Island Lake.

OGeez! is also teaming up with the vape company Timeless and Bloc dispensary to sponsor a Mortal Kombat tournament at Midlane Esports, a Chicago-based eSports venue. The tournament starts this month with "qualifiers" and then moves on to three

more rounds. OGeez! is also sponsoring a graduation party for University of Illinois students at nuEra Dispensary in Champaign, holding a Retro Arcade Game Night at Emerald Lounge and hosting another Bleed for Weed Blood Drive at Parkway Dispensary in Tilton.

"OGeez! gummies are amazing," one budtender said. "That's why they're breaking further into the market here every day.'



## Sugar Free Hits NJ Shelves!

n a surprise move, OGeez! has launched its Sugar Free Tropical gummy in New Jersey. ·Cannabis experts assumed the company would wait until later this year to launch the blockbuster product, but were reportedly ecstatic that OGeez! made such a bold move. The gummy is already available at a number of Garden State dispensaries, including Twisted Hat,

Bay Street Greenery and Bcaf (see full list). The move came just a month after OGeez! launched its Big RSO in New Jersey and right after the

launch of Sugar Free and Live Rosin in Illinois. A spokesperson for OGeez! said there was a "sugar free void" in New Jersey and that consumers

have been "clamouring for a great-tasting gummy with no sugar."

Geez! trucks hit the streets last month to start delivering Sugar Free Tropical gummies to New Jersey's dispensaries. Here are the first dispensaries to have them on their shelves.
