## Live Rosin Flavor Hits The Market

Geez! is officially upping its Live Rosin game.

The company is launching a new, all-natural sativa Live Rosin vegan gummy in Sweet Lemon.

OGeez! confirmed the news after a prominent vegan influencer began posting about it.

"The posts are true! We've been working on it for a while and we're finally unveiling it," said one OGeez! executive. The launch adds a second Live Rosin option to the OGeez! mix. The company's original — a Sweet Clementine gummy who

made a name for herself on the vegan speaking circuit — comes in indica and has been a huge success. "The original Live Rosin has led the way," the executive said. "We wanted to build on that success by offering Live Rosin in

another citrus flavor, but also giving consumers a sativa option."

The overlap between vegans and cannabis consumers is "pretty insane," said one dispensary owner. "When you see the Venn diagram it really hits home," he said, adding that OGeez!'s Live Rosin is known as the "Whole Foods-meets-Farmer's Market" gummy.

Sweet Lemon will roll out this month in Illinois and Arizona, where OGeez! held a "Sweet Lemon" infused dinner on October 1st. Sources say it will launch in New Jersey soon as well.

he term gets tossed around a lot, but what exactly is Live Rosin? In a nutshell, it's a solventless concentrate that offers a very pure form of cannabis. It starts when freshly harvested cannabis is frozen, locking in the plant's cannabinoids and terpenes. Then the plant goes through an ice water extraction and a heat-and-pressure finish. The result is a terpene-rich concentrate or sap.

Unlike live resin — which is created with the use of solvents and is centuries old — live rosin has only been around since about 2015. That's when California dispensary owner and grower Phil "Soilgrown" Salazar accidentally discovered it. According to news reports, he was using a hair straightener to thin out no-melt hash when he stumbled upon cannabis's next great innovation.

## Welcome to RSOctober!

s if the RSO needed any more love. OGeez! is now putting its growing family of RSO

gummies on promotion for the entire month in Arizona. Peg's Raspberry Orange RSO and Peg's Big RSO — both top sellers — will be included in the campaign, which will run at a number of Arizona dispensaries. Zen Leaf's New Jersey dispensaries are also all signed on, according to sources.

Reporters have descended on OGeez! headquarters to find out why it's promoting one of its most popular gummies.

One OGeez! executive said the company wants to ensure that consumers have access to its RSOs because they "provide immense relief." Sources say dispensaries have hired extra staff to handle the expected spike in traffic.

That's all as the industry waits for Peg's Sativa RSO — the pink lemonade gummy that's infused with the iconic sativa Maui Wowie strain — to be added to the OGeez! permanent line-up.

"All the talk is about RSOs right now," one budtender said. "The spotlight is on the RSOs and they are shining.
