Minis Make Arizona Comeback!

Something strange is happening in Arizona: OGeez! Minis are coming back after going missing for roughly two years. News has been spreading like wildfire that the beloved 3-milligram gummies will be re-launching in the state in the middle of this month.

Sources say the Minis were on a leave of absence from OGeez!, but have dealt with some family issues and are now “revved up” and ready to “make a major splash” with their relaunch.

“Their family drama has been dealt with and they are coming out of it stronger and in better shape than ever,” said one OGeez! executive.

The small-but-mighty gummies were the first-ever minis to hit the Arizona market when they launched back in 2022. They had a very successful run, but suddenly disappeared in early 2024 without explanation.

“They were a big-time favorite for experienced cannabis users and for those just testing the waters,” sources said.

One source said the Minis had the full backing of OGeez! to get through its rough patch and that the company did a great job maintaining the gummies’ privacy.

The Minis will continue to come in Fruit and Cream bags in both indica and sativa — with 25 gummies per bag.

Feed for Weed in NJ!

OGeez! is partnering with RISE in New Jersey on its first-ever Garden State food drive. The drive — which launched late last month on Giving Tuesday — will start at the dispensary’s Bloomfield location and then roll out at its Patterson outpost.

RISE customers who donate to the collection will receive an additional 5% off any bag of OGeez! as well as OGeez! swag.

The food will ultimately be donated to MEND, a non-profit hunger relief network, which operates food pantries in Essex County, New Jersey.

“Food insecurity is obviously rampant right now. We are so glad to be partnering with RISE to do our small part to help,” said Allison Zuckerman, the General Manager of OGeez! New Jersey.



Revolutionary Infusion in Works?

OGeez! may have a ‘revolutionary’ product up its sleeve for 2026.

The company is working on a new type of gummy with an infusion method and flavor that have never been seen in the U.S. market, according to sealed documents that were leaked to the Dispatch.

The documents include diagrams of a triple-layered gummy with notes in the margins about a triple infusion and red, white and blue colors.

OGeez! declined to comment and fired off a cease-and-desist letter to the Dispatch.

The Dispatch’s editor said the information was too vital for the cannabis industry to hold back.



Product Drops Get Closer



OGeez! is gearing up to unleash a slew of new gummies into its three markets.

This month, both New Jersey and Illinois will be bringing on Big Sleep, the mega-sized 2-to-1 mix of THC and CBN. The gummy, which comes in aquaberry, is known as the company’s workhorse, consistently driving business to its dispensaries.

“We’ll be out delivering the first week of December,” said one OGeez! source, noting that dispensaries began pre-ordering at the end of November. “Our sleep gummies are always among our top sellers so we’re expecting big things.”

Meanwhile, New Jersey will also be stocking dispensary shelves with Peg’s Sativa RSO — which is undergoing a packaging redesign with its transition from a summer gummy to part of the permanent lineup — and its new Sweet Lemon Sativa Live Rosin.

As the OGeez! source said: “We’ve pushed to get these gummies out before the holidays because we know the demand is big.”

An AZ December to Remember

OGeez! continues to fire on all cylinders in Arizona.

The company will be hopping between events and running promotions throughout December in the Grand Canyon State.

On December 6, OGeez! will be at Arizona Organix to celebrate the dispensary’s 13th anniversary. The event will include vendors, games, food trucks and an on-site consumption space.

OGeez! will also be at Arizona Brunch Fest, held at Scottsdale Stadium and featuring top Phoenix brunch spots along with mimosas, cocktails and local craft beer.

And it will be at Trulieve North Mountain for the dispensary’s “12 Days of Christmas” campaign. OGeez! will be on-site with free tacos from Enrique’s Kitchen.

Dispensaries throughout the state are also running bread-and-butter promotions on OGeez! Fruits, Creams and Sugar Free Tropical.

“OGeez! is the perfect stocking stuffer, Hanukkah gift or just general holiday thank you,” said one budtender. “We’re expecting OGeez! gift giving to soar this month.”

Sleep Gummy Lovers

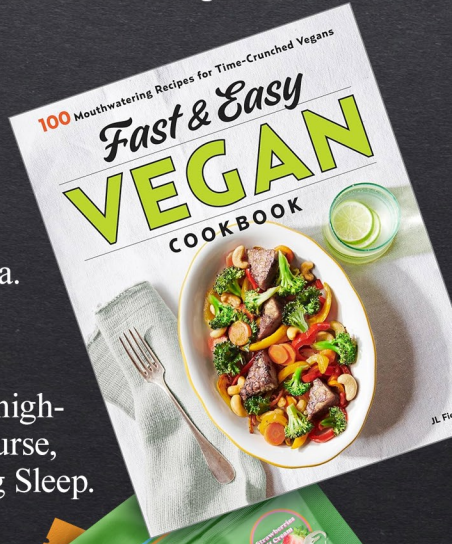
