OGeez! Launches Revolutionary Triple Infusion Gummy

OGeez! is starting 2026 off with a bang.

The company has long been known for its signature double-layered gummy. But it's now taking it up a notch in what many are calling a "revolutionary" gummy development.

The company confirmed that it's launching a triple-layered gummy this month in Illinois, with Arizona and New Jersey next in line.

The red-white-and-blue Triple Infusion is reportedly being timed to the United States Semiquincentennial, which has been dubbed "America250."

OGeez! declined to confirm the Semiquincentennial connection, but the color scheme and timing have led to speculation that the company had 1776 in mind.

Cannabis experts say the most stunning feat is that the gummy has three separate infusions: The red layer is RSO; the white layer is distillate extract; and the blue layer is Live Rosin.

"This is OGeez!'s boldest innovation yet" one cannabis insider said. "It's where serious cannabis expertise meets cannabis confectionary imagination as we have never seen before."

The Rocket Pop flavor — a combination of lime, cherry and blue raspberry like the famed ice pop — comes in a dark blue bag with colorful fireworks and the OGeez! logo outlined in shimmery silver.

Sources say OGeez! is planning campaigns for July 4th that will "pull out all the stops" and that red-white-and-blue lanyards and pins are in production now for budtenders.

The gummy will be available in 10-pack bags and as a BIG — a 100-milligram gummy — in Illinois this month.

An OGeez! spokesperson said the company is "extremely proud to have created the first triple-infused gummy on the U.S. market."



Rocket Pop's Rave Reviews

The early reviews for the new OGeez! Triple Infusion gummy are nothing shy of glowing.

"This gummy is the trifecta," said one cannabis critic. "It looks magnificent, it tastes amazing and the effect is so unique because of the three different cannabis components."

Another reviewer said she's been in the business for a decade and has "never seen or tasted anything like it."

"I still don't fully get how OGeez! even created it," she said. "To say it's a standout would be a huge understatement. This is quite a way to kick off 2026."

Is Cannabis Finally Getting Reclassified?

Um ... what just happened?

Last month, President Trump signed an executive order to fast-track the rescheduling of cannabis from a Schedule I substance (which includes heroin and LSD) to a Schedule III (which includes Tylenol with codeine).

The rescheduling — which was started by President Biden, but didn't cross the finish line before he left office — would only cover medicinal cannabis and would not legally federalize cannabis.

But if it clears a few more hurdles it would mark a historic step forward for the industry and a massive shift in federal cannabis policy. Not only would it open the floodgates for research, it would drastically decrease tax liabilities for the industry, bolstering financial stability for cannabis companies across the board.

The industry was abuzz with excitement and is now anxiously waiting to see what happens. "This could be the dawn of a new era," one cannabis expert said.



Flavoring the New Year!


OGeez! is going batty with new products, promotions and marketing campaigns in the New Year.

For starters, Arizona is now launching Peg's RSO Sativa — the limited edition Pink Lemonade summer gummy that's been added to the permanent OGeez! lineup because of its unprecedented popularity. Meanwhile, OGeez! is rolling out a "Go Big for the New Year" campaign in Arizona centered on its BIG gummies.

Arizona will also have promotions for the Fruits, Creams and Sugar Free gummies and for its 1,000 milligram medical sleep gummy.
